Simple needle Case



Requirements

- Two 6" squares of fabric
- One 4³/₄" square of felt
- Button, popper or Velcro dot for fastening

Making up


Using $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam, sew together the two squares of fabric, right sides facing, leaving a small gap through which to turn the squares.

Turn squares so that right side of fabric is outside, hand close the gap.

(If one of the squares is made from two triangles, the gap can be in the centre of the seam which joins the triangles. This will fall behind the felt and closing the gap need not be so meticulously tidy!!!)

Make marks 1" from one of the corners of the felt, on either side of the corner. Join these marks and cut off the small triangle.

Make a mark 2¹/₄" from the opposite corner of the felt, on either side of the corner. Join these marks and cut off the larger triangle.



Place felt piece centrally on fabric square and sew along small dotted line, forming a V shape

Fold in long triangles followed by top triangle, attach fastening and you are done!

I added a chord made from embroidery thread to the bottom of my needle case, so that I could keep a pair of scissors handy.
